All regular buyers needing more to fill orders, and in addition, 2 new faces appeared to add even more spice to our regular competitive crowd.

New Season Lambs were a flyer, with many more orders than Lambs. **MANY MANY MORE COULD HAVE BEEN SOLD AT SIMILAR RATES**

All top quality made in excess of 280p/kg with Andrew Bennett's outstanding lambs peaking at 314p/kg for 39.8kg. Most well finished lambs of the most popular weight (34-40kg) were in excess of 260p, with stronger trade than expected for heavier weights.

Surprisingly, for the time of year, the quality of Old Season Lambs were better than last week, although with numbers considerably less, and several vendors on their last consignments.

Several pens of better quality made in excess of 180p/kg to a top of 203p/kg for Dan Mycocks 52.7kg Texel crosses, with 4 customers still actively bidding, and heavier weights all making over £100 per head.
